## Youth Basketball 2012

1. These rules are in addition to the General Bylaws For All Community League Sports and to the Youth Basketball Bylaws. Coaches should read, be aware of and abide by these regulations, and encourage their players and parents to do the same.
2. **Unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches, or spectators towards opposing teams, officials, or staff will not be tolerated. Head coaches are responsible for the conduct of their assistant coaches, players, and parents.**
3. No grace period. Scheduled game time is forfeit time. Teams should be at the site 30 minutes before game time. Games may start early if both teams are ready, but no later than scheduled.
4. Home team is listed to the right on the schedule and will sit on the scorer's left unless instructed otherwise by the gym supervisor. If both teams have the same uniform color, it is the home team's responsibility to provide an alternate color.
5. **Hard objects in the hair, necklaces, watches, bracelets, rings, or other jewelry are prohibited items. No tape-ups or cover-ups will be allowed – these items must be removed to play. This is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced.**
6. **Uniforms CANNOT have pockets or zippers. No tape-ups, cover-ups, or inside-outs will be allowed. This is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced.**

### **7. CONTRACT CARDS AND TEAM ROSTERS**

- **Rosters freeze on Tuesdays at 5:00pm all Wednesday games.**
- **Rosters freeze on Thursdays at 5:00pm for all Saturday games.**
- **Rosters freeze on Fridays at 5:00pm for all Monday games.**
- **The Athletic Office will provide official team rosters to the scorer's table. ONLY PLAYERS WHO HAVE COMPLETED ALL ROSTER REQUIREMENTS, AND ONLY COACHES WHO HAVE SUBMITTED A CRIMINAL HISTORY BACKGROUND REQUEST FORM, WILL APPEAR ON THIS ROSTER AND BE ALLOWED TO OCCUPY THE TEAM BENCH DURING GAMES. MAXIMUM 15 PLAYERS AND THREE COACHES PER TEAM.**
- **Final cut-off: 5:00 p.m. Thursday, February 2, 2012. No new players/coaches added after this date.**

8. A mandatory play rule is in effect for all leagues. Each player in attendance must play one uninterrupted quarter at the earliest opportunity. It is the coach's responsibility to keep account of the action. Failure to comply with the mandatory play rule will result in forfeiture at the point of the infraction. **Injury clause: if a player is injured and taken out of the game before he/she has completed the mandatory playing requirement, he/she must still play a full quarter if he/she is able to return to the game.** Refer to the Youth Basketball Bylaws for further information.
9. Defense in the back court: When a team is leading by ten (10) or more points in Midget and Preteen, or by twenty (20) or more points in Intermediate, Junior, and Senior, that team will not be allowed to start their defense until the offensive player is in the front court, three feet inside the mid-court line. First infraction of this rule shall result in a warning, ball out of bounds to the offensive team. **There will be one warning, per half, per team.** Second and subsequent infractions will result in an illegal defense penalty (giving the team behind two free throws and possession of the ball). Refer to the Youth Basketball Bylaws for further information.
10. All games count in the standings. The team with the best win-loss record in each division will be the Division Champion. In case of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place, all tied teams will be declared Co-Champions. There is no post-season play. Games canceled because of inclement weather will not be rescheduled.
11. All spectators, players and coaches must stay in areas designated by the gym supervisor.
12. Please help us keep the gyms clean by checking your area for trash once your game is finished.
13. **School Board Policy and Virginia State Law prohibits smoking and use of tobacco products on school property at all times.**
